| <u>Lyon</u> | A 3.5-hour drive from Visp takes you to the junction of the Saône and Rhone rivers, where you'll discover a vibrant city with unique Renaissance architecture. |
| <u>Strasbourg</u> | The capital of Alsace offers a mixture of German and French influences, and is less than four hours away. |
| <u>Paris</u> | Get on a train in Visp in the morning and enjoy gastronomy, art, fashion and culture in the French capital at lunchtime. |
| <u>Piedmont</u> | Piedmont, with its capital Turin, shares a border with Valais and is internationally renowned for its cuisine and Barolo wine. |

| <u>Cinque Terre</u> | Particularly renowned for its climbing, the national park and its five villages on the Ligurian coast are only five hours' drive away. |
| <u>Lake Garda</u> | Italy's biggest lake is less than four hours away. It is surrounded by a host of beautiful destinations and attractions such as the Gardaland theme park. |
| <u>Venice</u> | Known for its canals and churches, Venice is considered one of the most romantic destinations in Europe, and is only five hours' drive from Visp. |
| <u>Lake Constance- region</u> | Less than four hours away is a diverse region in the heart of nature that's nonetheless home to vibrant cities like Constance and Bregenz. |
| <u>Black forest</u> | Guests who make the three-hour journey from Visp to the Black Forest are rewarded with dense forests, picturesque villages and a renowned wellness region. |
