There is no general obligation to vaccinate in Switzerland.

There is no general obligation to vaccinate in Switzerland. The Federal Office of Public Health (BAG) provides a vaccination plan which recommends the age at which children should be vaccinated against diseases such as measles, whooping cough, rubella or tetanus. The costs for the recommended vaccinations are usually covered by basic health insurance. Your paediatrician or parents' counselling centre will provide detailed information. If there are any discrepancies with the vaccination timeline in your previous place of residence, you can get help drawing up a personalised vaccination schedule.
